## HANSON PLACE SDA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL'S <u>CODE OF CONDUCT</u>

#### **General Behavior**

In general, all students are entitled to enjoy the basic rights of citizenship recognized by law for persons of age and maturity. The Hanson Place SDA School will foster a climate of mutual respect for the rights of others. Each student is expected to respect the rights and privileges of other students, teachers and staff, at all times.

All members of the Hanson Place SDA School share in the responsibility for the supervision of student behavior. Parents and guardians must also assume the responsibility for the conduct of their child.

The student's responsibility for achieving a positive learning environment at school and/or school-related activities shall include the following:

- 1. Attend all classes daily and be on time.
- 2. Prepare for each class with appropriate materials and completed assignments.
- 3. <u>Dress according to the school's dress code</u>. Hats are not to be worn in any part of the building.
- 4. Know that the use and possession of illegal or unauthorized drugs, alcohol and weapons are unlawful and prohibited.
- 5. Have respect for others. Bullying is not tolerated.
- 6. Conduct one's self in a responsible manner.
- 7. Know and obey all school and classroom rules.
- 8. Cooperate with school staff always. Should there be the need for an investigation and disciplinary measures, you are expected to respectfully comply.
- 9. Eating is done in the Cafeteria only.
- 10. Gum chewing and candy eating are prohibited in the school.
- 11. Radios, walkmans, beepers, cellular phones and games are not to be brought to school. If confiscated they will not be returned.
- 12. Keep your desk area clean at all times.
- 13. Homework is to be done daily. There is homework detention.
- 14. Enter the classroom quietly, take your assigned seat and follow your teacher's instruction.

#### **REASONS FOR DISMISSAL**

Some practices are not permitted in Christian schools. Since the Hanson Place SDA School would not knowingly accept students who offend in these practices, the <u>first offense</u> in any of the following makes a student subject to disciplinary action: *immediate suspension, expulsion or dismissal* from Hanson Place SDA School.

Students attending the Hanson Place SDA School are prohibited from the following engaging in any of the following behaviors:

#### NON-NEGOTIABLE BEHAVIOR THAT MAY LEAD TO EXPULSION

- 1. Using narcotics, tobacco, illegal drugs or having possession of such drugs.
- 2. Drinking, handling or possessing alcoholic beverages, or furnishing alcohol beverages to others.
- Betting or gambling.
- 4. Using profane language or displaying lewd or suggestive conducts.
- 5. Possessing on school grounds any weapons/articles with the intention to harm or incapacitate another.
- 6. Dishonesty, including theft.
- 7. Possessing paging devices (beepers), radios or video games, cellular phones.
- 8. Willful destruction of any school property (this includes text books) or vandalism.
- 9. Cheating on examination or classroom.
- 10. Willful deception regarding violation of rules.
- 11. Improper sexual conduct, i.e. sexual harassment or implications of sexual nature, including the use of words, gestures, or possession of obscene literature/pictures, sexting or pornography of any sort.
- 12. Leaving school grounds without proper permission.
- 13. Insubordination by constant violations of school and classroom rules.
- 14. Consistent failure to complete assignments.
- 15. Displaying any unacceptable physical acts such as hitting, kicking and punching or inciting a fight.
- 16. Harassing or bullying other students.
- 17. Engaging in any conduct that disrupts the school environment or education process.
- 18. Disruption or unsafe behaviors on school trips.

#### **DISCIPLINE**

The self-government of the student is the object of discipline. Directing this development without hindering it by control is the continued study of the Hanson Place S.D.A. School. Students are expected to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner, both on and off school grounds.

When imposing discipline, the staff at Hanson Place S.D.A. School will adhere to the following general guidelines:

- 1. Discipline will be administered, when necessary, to protect students, school staff or property and to maintain essential order and discipline.
- 2. Students will be treated fairly and equitably. Discipline will be based on a careful assessment of the circumstances of each case:
  - a. Seriousness of the offense
  - b. Student's age
  - c. Frequency of misconduct
  - d. Students attitude
  - e. Potential effect of the misconduct on the school environment.

Disciplinary action may include, but not limited to:

- 1. Teacher/Parent/Student/Principal conferences
- 2. Restitution or restoration, as applicable, for destruction or vandalism of property.
- 3. Exclusion from extracurricular activities, such as field trips.
- 4. Suspension for up to three days.
- 5. Expulsion/dismissal from school.
- 6. Any other disciplinary action as determined by the principal, such as detention. **There is no corporal punishment.**

#### DRESS CODE/STANDARD

Neat and attractive clothing promote a good self-image and a better environment for learning. Students are therefore encouraged to dress in harmony with the basic principles of health, modesty and appropriateness. The following will not be allowed to be worn at school:

- 1. Jewelry: bracelets, non-medical I.D. bracelets, rings, earrings and necklaces. (If confiscated the item will not be returned).
- 2. Extreme styles or coloring of hair.
- 3. Heavy make-up.
- 4. Immodest hemlines (above the knees)
